Vestry Meeting  
June 22, 2011

Present: Pastor Allen, Senior Warden Mike Figura, Junior Warden Gary Palmer, Dave Simmons, Mary Ann Sulick, and Marcia Fish.

Absent: Mary Darnell, Zach Frey, and Lenn Mercer.

Pastor Allen opened the meeting with prayer at 7:15 PM and stated that he had been notified at the last minute that a third member could not attend the meeting so there was not a quorum.

Those present joined in the discussion of John 14 and 16, Romans 8 and Acts 2 and their notes on what the Holy Spirit does and who He is.

As there was not a quorum, the minutes of the May 25 were reviewed, but not approved.

After the review of the Finance Committee reports, there was a prayer for wisdom in using God's money.

Rector's Report: Pastor Allen said that two women in the parish independently of each other said they wanted to do a testimony about helping women obtain forgiveness after having an abortion. Last week he and 14 others attended a successful Lighthouse Retreat near Flint. He is encouraged by the growth in discipleship being demonstrated by Bible study at the home of Father Greg and Alice McComas on Fridays, by the Bible study at Bobby Gorton's home on Fridays and by the discussions at the Brotherhood meetings on Saturday mornings.

1. Mary Ann reported that the Picnic on June 12 went very well. Left over food was taken with other donations from Joe's Produce to My Brother's Keeper on Monday.

2. We have a shortage of volunteers needed for ministry help at the 10 AM services. We especially need volunteers for ushers, bread delivery and greeters.
